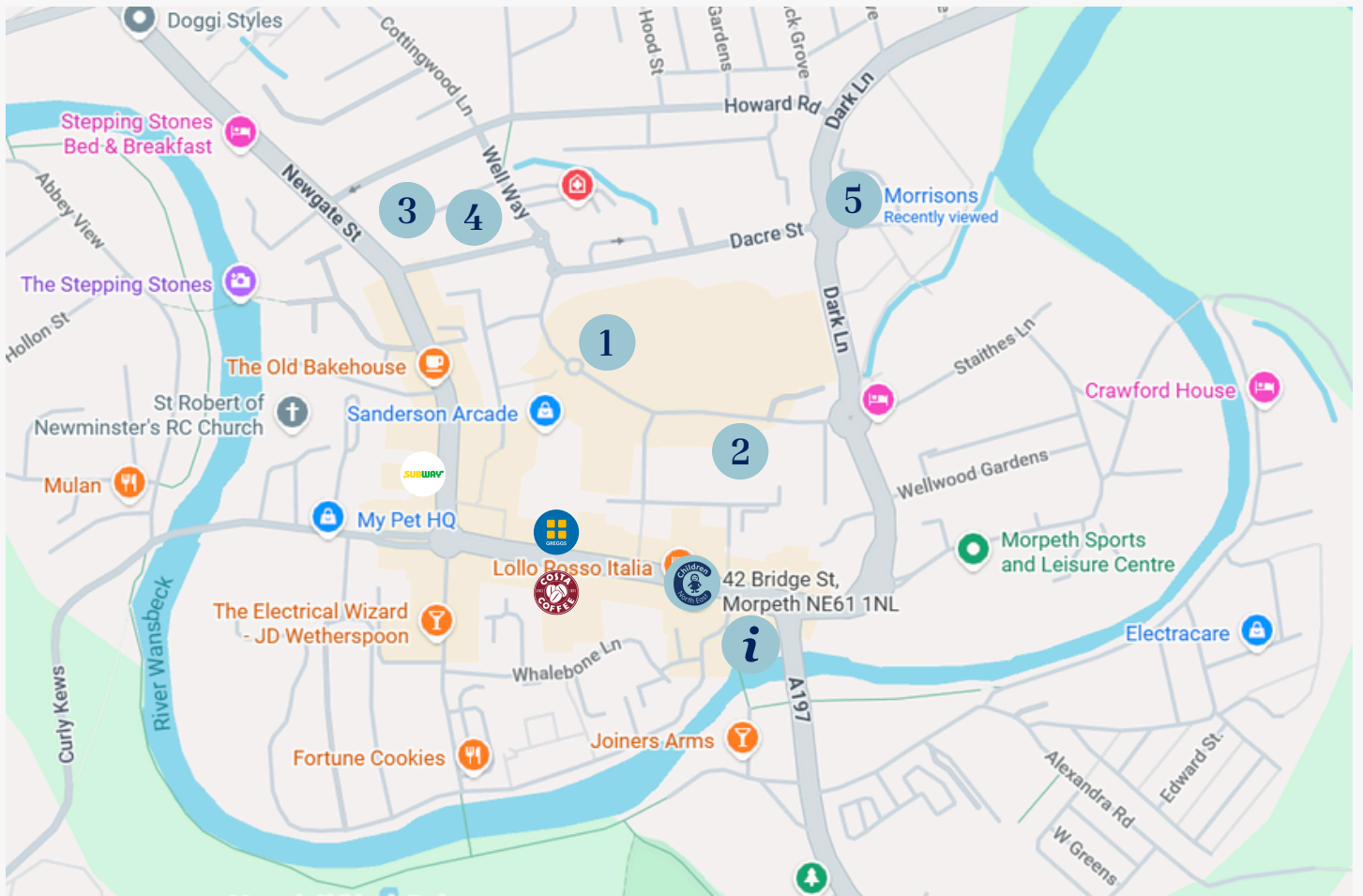
Front loading: Bridge Street
