

# Clarty Big Bairns 2026 Terms and Conditions



By registering for a charity place with Children North East for the Clarty Big Bairns 2026, you agree to the following terms and conditions.

## 1. About the Event

Clarty Big Bairns 2026 is an adult obstacle course event organised by Challenge Northumberland. Children North East is offering charity places for participants who wish to fundraise in support of babies, children, young people and families across the North East.

## 2. Eligibility

Participants must be aged 18+ by the date of the event. By registering, you confirm that you are medically fit to participate in a physically demanding obstacle course.

## 3. Your Charity Place

Children North East has 20 spaces available for Clarty Big Bairns 2026. Places are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. A non-refundable registration fee of £39 per person is required to secure your spot.

Spaces are subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed until registration has been completed and payment received.

## 4. Fundraising

Participants are asked to raise a suggested minimum fundraising target of £250 per person. Fundraising is vital to enabling Children North East to continue supporting babies, children, young people and families across the North East.

A fundraising total of £250 could help provide a neurodiverse young person with a full year of peer support sessions, offer three counselling sessions to young people who have experienced abuse, and support five children to attend cooking sessions with their families, learning how to prepare and enjoy a nutritious hot meal together.

### By taking part, you agree to:

- Fundraise in a legal and responsible manner
- Comply with the [Code of Fundraising Practice](#) issued by the Fundraising Regulator
- Ensure all funds raised are paid to Children North East within 30 days of the event

## 5. Registration Fees and Donations

Registration fees and donations are non-refundable. All funds raised in connection with Clarty Big Bairns 2026 must be paid to Children North East.

## 6. Cancellation, Withdrawal and Deferral

If you are unable to take part, please contact the fundraising team as soon as possible. Charity places cannot be deferred or refunded unless explicitly agreed by Children North East.

Children North East reserves the right to withdraw a participant's place if they breach these Terms & Conditions.

## 7. Event Organisation and Liability

Clarty Big Bairns 2026 is organised and managed by Challenge Northumberland. Children North East is not responsible for the organisation, management or delivery of the event and accepts no liability for any injury, loss or damage suffered as a result of participation.

Participants must comply with all event rules, safety guidance and instructions issued by Challenge Northumberland.

## 8. Health, Safety and Fitness

Participants take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own health, fitness and wellbeing. You should consult your GP if you have any medical conditions or concerns about your ability to take part. Appropriate clothing and footwear must be worn at all times.

The event organisers are responsible for carrying out appropriate risk assessments and will have experienced marshals positioned around the course to help oversee participant safety. Participants must follow all safety guidance and instructions provided on the day.

Alcohol will only be provided to participants aged 18 or over, and valid photographic identification may be required.

## 9. Personal Data and Photography

Children North East will use your personal data to administer your place, support your fundraising and communicate with you about the event. Your details may be shared with Challenge Northumberland for event administration, safety and logistical purposes.

All personal data will be processed in line with our [Privacy Policy](#).

Photography and video footage may be taken during the event and used by Children North East for promotional purposes, including on our website, social media, and printed or digital materials. By taking part, you consent to the use of your image for these purposes.



## 11. Event Changes or Cancellation

In the unlikely event that Clarty Big Bairns 2026 is cancelled, postponed or altered, Children North East cannot guarantee refunds of registration fees or fundraising income. Decisions relating to the event are the responsibility of Challenge Northumberland.
